

Minutes of a special session of the Common Council of the City of Barron held April 26, 2016 at 5:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Council President Rod Nordby.

Discussion took place on the recommendation of the Chief of Police and K-9 officer to purchase a 23 month old dog from the Kettle Moraine Police K-9 Academy in Campbellsport, Wisconsin. This \$9,000.00 purchase would include four weeks of training for the K-9 officer at the academy. The dog is currently trained in narcotics and patrol.


