

Minutes of a special session of the Common Council of the City of Barron held August 29, 2014 at 7:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Council members present: David Vruwink, Rod Nordby, Kevin Haller, Mike Dietrich and Tony Allen. Absent: Maureen Tollman and Mark Thompson. Others present: Dave Hanson, Mike Buck and Troy Hom.

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 a.m. by Mayor David Vruwink.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given at this time.

Roll was taken and a quorum was declared.

Mike Buck, C.E.O. with Consumers Co-Op Association of Eau Claire (Mega Foods) appeared to request a Class "A" Combination Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License at 622 East LaSalle Avenue for the period September 29, 2014 thru June 30, 2015. They will be acquiring Econo Foods on that date.

Moved by Nordby, seconded by Haller to grant Consumers Co-Op Association of Eau Claire the license as requested. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 naves.

Troy Hom, owner of the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Saloon, 48 South 5<sup>th</sup> Street appeared to request permission to block off the alley located south of their business on Sunday, September 14, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. to midnight and to allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages in a fenced off area during the same time.

Moved by Nordby, seconded by Haller to approve both requests as outlined above. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 naves.

An e-mail dated August 22, 2014 from Jan Jorgenson, Secretary with the Barron Chamber of Commerce was reviewed regarding the Fall Fest on September 6, 2014. They would like to close part of the street in Anderson Park between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to improve safety for children attending some of their activities.

Moved by Allen, seconded by Nordby to approve the request for closing the street in Anderson Park and direct Dave Hanson, Street Commissioner to work with Jan Jorgenson to complete the necessary details to close said street. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 naves.

Mayor Vruwink updated the members of the city council on their recent committee meeting on this year's bow and arrow deer hunt. The necessary forms have all been updated and a notice will appear in the local paper advising people of the hunt.

Moved by Haller, seconded by Nordby to authorize the bow and arrow deer hunt from September 13, 2014 to January 4, 2015 as recommended by the committee overseeing the deer hunt. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 naves.
