



The Barron Federated Music Club will be sponsoring a concert on Sunday, October 1st, at 2:00 pm in the First Lutheran Church sanctuary. This is the club's annual fund raiser to provide music scholarships for Barron area students. Featured this year will be Lynn Emmons on piano and organ, and the Higher Vision Gospel Quartet.

Lynn has her Master's Degree in Education and is a middle school ESL teacher in Barron. She is a Nationally Certified Teacher of Music in Piano and maintains a private piano studio at home. In 2012, Lynn had the privilege of playing a piano concerto with the Rice Lake Red Cedar Symphony Orchestra and also was their featured organist in 2016.
