Duties include, but not limited to: maintenance of vehicles, buildings, and park facilities, concrete and asphalt repair, grass mowing and plowing of snow and ice. Regularly operates single and tandem axle trucks or other assigned vehicles. Also, performs work in cemetery and outdoor pool. Past cemetery experience and mechanical background preferred. This full-time position is eligible for a competitive salary and benefits package including medical, vision, and retirement matching.
