

## **APPRENTICE LINEMAN City of Barron**

The City of Barron is now accepting resumes for a full-time Apprentice Lineman. This position reports to the Utility Manager. Apprentice Linemen perform a wide variety of diverse work including erecting, repairing and operating the city electrical distribution system facilities. Works on energized lines, structures and equipment; provide service and perform line construction and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical distribution facilities. Must be available for overtime work in case of emergency and to be on call status, work with other staff when needed, and assist with the preparation of special events. Certification as a graduate of line worker school or successful completion of related courses with a combination of training and experience will be considered. Must have a current commercial driver's license (CDL) and a good driving record. Starting salary depends on qualifications with a minimum of \$20.88 per hour plus generous benefit package. Description Electric Lineman – this position performs complex supervisory and skilled work in the construction, maintenance, and repair of all components of an electric distribution system. An employee in this class may participate in a variety of skilled and technical tasks associated with the electric distribution facilities and lines. Employee must be able to work on independent work assignments and projects including the splicing, repair and maintenance of electric lines, replacement of poles, cross arms, transformers, services, maintenance of substations and peak shaving generators. Work also involves assisting Electric Superintendent with inventory ordering and stocking, policies and procedures, project planning and configuration, work prioritization, equipment maintenance, and related activities. The employee is required to have considerable knowledge of the safety requirements and possible hazards involved in power line work. Independent judgment is exercised in determining the most appropriate methods and equipment when working with high voltage lines. Work requires frequent on-call and call-back responsibilities. Work is performed under general supervision of the Electric Superintendent and is evaluated through periodic conferences, observation of results achieved, and review of records, reports and files. Candidate should possess considerable knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions involved in power line work and the principles of electricity as related to transmission and distribution, as well as knowledge of the standard techniques and practices used in underground and overhead power line construction and maintenance work. Education and Certifications: Graduation from high school or GED; supplemented with technical courses related to technology, electricity and electrical theory or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Certification as a graduate of line worker schools

and related courses equivalent combination of training and experience is preferred. This full-time position is eligible for a competitive salary and benefits package including medical, vision, and retirement matching.
