 - i. 100 E Wisconsin Avenue
 - ii. 1481 E Division Avenue
 - iii. 407 E Division Avenue
 - iv. 106 E Franklin Avenue
 - b. Wis. Stat. § 19.85 (1)(e) to deliberate or negotiate the purchase of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business. This relates to 1) an agreement between City of Barron, Kwik Trip, and the Barron Mobile Home Park, and 2) airport hangar leases.
 - c. Wis. Stat. § 19.85 (1)(f), considering financial, medical, social, or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations. This relates to 156 S 14th Street.
