The Barron Area Community Center (BACC) is a non-profit corporation devoted to promoting a healthy lifestyle through social, cultural, recreational, and physical fitness opportunities. The BACC has and continues to enrich the quality of life for many Barron Area residents. It's estimated that over 180,000 people use or visit the facility annually. The 48,000 square foot facility includes a 500 seat theater, walking/running track, gymnasium, pool area with whirlpool and sauna, 2 racquetball/wallyball courts, free weights area, selectorized weight machines, numerous cardiovascular machines, aerobics room, and meeting rooms.

Members and guests range in age from infant to 100+ and there is something for everyone. Activities offered include: water aerobic classes, youth and adult rec programs and leagues, swim lessons, kids parties, land aerobics classes (including yoga and TRX), personal training options, plays, musical performances, birthday party packages, and much more.
